HELCOM Response - Regulatory mandate

- Helsinki Convention Article 14 on Co-operation in combatting marine pollution: The
 Contracting Parties shall individually and jointly take, as set out in Annex VII; all appropriate
 measures to maintain adequate ability and to respond to pollution incidents in order to eliminate
 or minimize the consequences of these incidents to the marine environment of the Builtir Sea
 Area.
- Annex VII of the Hebinki Convention on Response to Pollution Incidents: The HELCOMI
 countries have agreed to maintain the obility to respond to pollution incidents threatening the
 morine environment of the Baltic Sea Area. This ability shall include adequate equipment, ships
 and manpower prepared for operations at sea or on the share.
 - Regulation 10 on Regular Co-operation: The Contracting Porties shall on a regular basis amongs joint operational combatting exercises as well as alarm exercises. The Contracting Parties shall also on a regular basis arrange exercises on the share.
 - Regulation 11 on application of the HELCOM Response Manual: The Contracting Parties
 agree to apply, as for as practicable, the principles and rules included in the HELCOM Manual
 on Co-operation in Response to Marine Pollution, detailing this Annex and adapted by the
 Commission or by the Group designated by the Commission for this purpose.

Seabirds ingest plastics, and use it in their nests (where adults and young can get entangled). It's been featured in nature documentaries & in the media, but how much do we REALLY know? **#POPCORN2022** 2/10







Lots of data about plastic ingestion is old. Production is going up exponentially, but some species haven't been looked at since the 1980s. Months of Nina Ohanlon et al also found poor data reporting & many species with no data at all sciencedirect.com/science/articl... #POPCORN2022 3/10



Of the species *with* data, lots have small sample sizes. If we're serious about understanding plastic ingestion, we need to know the *current* extent of the problem, and which species/populations are most affected **#POPCORN2022** 4/10








In APP4SEA a smart map was put together for the whole NPA region. Authorities have their own operational tools for **#OSR**, but this kind of bigger map was missing. The map serves also public, informs them about oil spills, how well we are prepared for them, etc.

Map <u>app4sea.com</u> has main layer sections about 1) regional boundaries, 2) Oil industry, transport and response, 3) Climate, ocean and weather & 4) Ecological zones, which contain relevant information for OSR in map form – and also useful info section <u>#POPCORN2022</u>








There is information about the OSR response sites and vessels, about oil fields, and density of shipping traffic. There is also simulations of actual accidents and hypothetical cases, showing the spreading of oil after a spill **#POPCORN2022**





Climate, oceanographic and weather data play a great role in OSR (where does the oil drift, etc.). In addition to this, there is also ecological data, who are at risk, in case of oil spills. Latest addition to the map is Marine plastic pollution #POPCORN2022








The smart map has also data about marine plastic pollution, which are result of our <u>#PlasticsInTheSea</u> campaign. We created 4 hypothetical <u>#MarineLitter</u> cases, and <u>@Meteorologisk</u> used their <u>#OpenDrift</u> programme to create simulations for these. <u>#POPCORN2022</u>





First one was case Bergen, a plastic bottle that fell overboard on <u>#NYE</u> from a Hurtigruten boat on the west coast of Norway. This bottle drifted almost to the <u>#NorthCape</u> – over 2000 km - in the 5 months that we tracked this case <u>#MarineLitter</u> <u>#POPCORN2022</u>















#GhostGear, which was the focus of session 2 keynote, was the star of case Thurso. A part of fishing net was torn away from a fishing vessel and ended up from the Coast of **#Scotland** to the West coast of **#Norway #POPCORN2022**








#Some of the **#MarineLitter** are small already when they enter the sea. The next case of Turku was about 50 cigarette butts, which well overboard from a ferry travelling between Turku and Stockholm. These spread far and widely in the **#BalticSea #POPCORN2022**









