

Administration

- 66 VFB:s with contracts done with F&RC:s

Rescue operations of VFB:s

- rescue missions (alarm calls)
- first response missions (together with paramedics)
- specialisation in rescue tasks: (e.g. 'heavy' water supply, animal rescue...)
- catering system for rescue operations 24/7

- Occupational safety team
- Development of the boat and vehicle fleet

 - assistance tasks (e.g. larger water supply problems in municipalities, temporary accommodation during larger fires, management and rescue support tasks during storms)






